**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

1.1 This friendly Regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, except as amended by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 This is a white sail regatta.

**2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES**

2.1 Participating keelboats must have a current SLVYRA handicap and enthusiastic participants must be female.

2.2 All PHRFs will be scored together.

2.3 Eligible boats must sail past the RC boat transom on starboard tack and request acknowledgment from Race Committee.

2.4 Eligibility is subject to completion of registration requirements.

**3. FEES**

3.1 An entry fee of \$5 CAD per person, payable by chit. (For visiting participants, please make cheques payable to Hudson Yacht Club and deliver at registration.)

3.2 Harbor fees are waived for participants.

**4. SCHEDULE**

4.1 Two (2) races are scheduled.

4.2 Registration/Skippers Meeting, held in the HYC bar, is 1100.

4.3 Warning signal of first race is 1230.

4.4 There will be no warning signal made after 1500.

4.5 Awards and refreshments will be presented afterwards at HYC.

**5. REGISTRATION**

5.2 No registrations will be accepted after 1000, Sunday, August 14th, 2011.

## 6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

## 7. **VENUE**

7.1 The Race Area will be on the Lake of Two Mountains, adjacent to the Hudson Yacht Club.

## 8. **COURSE**

8.1 The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

## 9. **SCORING**

9.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Rules of racing appendix A will apply as amended below.

9.2 One race must be sailed to constitute a Regatta.

9.3 In the case of a tie, the results of the last race will determine the standings.

## 10. **BERTHING**

10.1 Participating boats may use the Visitor's Dock on the day of the Regatta.

## 11. **PRIZES**

11.1 Competitors, partners and friends are invited to the HYC premises after the race. Keeper prizes will be awarded for the first, second and third places.

## 12. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

12.1 Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. (See rule 4 Decision to Race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction prior to, during or after the Regatta.

## 13. **INSURANCE**

13.1 Each participating boat must be insured with valid third party liability insurance covering an adequate amount.
