***NOTICE OF RACE***

**1 Organizing Authority**

1.1 The organizing authority is the Lake of Two-Mountains Sailing Clubs Association.

**2 Rules**

2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2.2 The SLVYRA PHRF rules will apply.

**3 Entries**

3.1 Each boat must have a current SLVYRA PHRF handicap.

3.2 Each boat must check in with the race committee before their warning signal.

3.3 Boats starting will be considered entered in the series regatta.

3.4 Boats sailing White Sail shall display a white ribbon from their backstay.

3.5 The helmsman must be a member of a club that belongs to CYA, FVQ, and SLVYRA.

The July 7 race will count only if one or more races are not started or abandoned.

5.2 The Warning Signal for the first race each day will be 1900

## **6 Racing area**

6.1 Race Area 1 will be west of the Oka-Como ferry.

6.2 Race Area 2 will be east of the Oka-Como ferry.

## **7 Scoring**

7.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.

7.2 There will be a ranking for each class.

7.3 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.4 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores (no drop). When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **8 Results**

8.1 Results for the races will be sent to all clubs as soon as possible after the race.

8.2 Results will be posted on the notice board of each club.

## **9 Prizes**

9.1 There will be a prize for first, second and third place in each class.

9.2 Prize-giving will be at HYC, Wednesday June 30 (or July 7 if there is a rerun) after the last Lake Championships race.

## **10 Sailing Instructions**

10.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at each participating club.
