NOTICE OF RACE

Revised May 8th, 2010

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, except as amended by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions
- 1.2 Current SLVYRA classifications will apply.
- 1.3 Current SLVYRA handicaps will apply, PHRF 1A, 1B, 2 and 3.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRIES

- 2.1 Entry is open to SLVYRA keel boats
- 2.2 PHRF 1B and PHRF 2 will be scored together.
- 2.3 The Race Committee will reserve the right to combine other PHRF classes based on the number of entries.
- 2.4 All classes must consist of three or more boats to be eligible to start a race
- 2,5 Eligible boats may enter the Regatta by sailing on starboard tack past the RC boat transom and requesting entry.

3. FEES

No entry fee will be applicable.

4. **SCHEDULE**

Six races are scheduled

Friday May 28, 2010

1800 – 2100 Registration

Saturday May 29, 2010

0930 Skipper's Meeting and Registration – Terrace HYC

1100 Warning signal of first race.

Sunday May 30, 2010

1100 Warning signal of first race

There will be No Warning Signal Made after 1430 May 31st.

1630 Award Presentations- HYC.

5. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and posted on the official notice board

6. **VENUE**

The Race will be sailed on the Lake of two Mountains.

7. **COURSE**

The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

8. **SCORING**

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Rules of racing appendix A will apply as amended below.

8.2 Three races must be sailed to constitute a Regatta.

8.3 When five or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.4 When six races have been completed. A boat's series score will be a total of her races excluding her worst score.

8.5 For HYC boats, the results of races 1, 2, and 3 will be scored for this regatta and the HYC Saturday Series A1, A2 and A3.

9. **BERTHING**

All club boats shall be kept in their assigned places.

Berthing for visiting boats on May 28, 29, 30 2010 is available.

10. **PRIZES**

10.1 Prizes will be awarded for first through third places in every qualifying fleet consisting of five boats.

10.2 If a fleet consists of less than five boats but more than three, prizes will be awarded to the first and second finishes.

11. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. (See rule 4 Decision to Race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction prior to, during or after the Regatta.

12. **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat will have to be insured with valid third party liability insurance covering an adequate amount.
