## **INTRODUCTION**

**ELIGIBILITY:** The course is open to juniors who are at least 8 years old and not over 16 years old as of June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2008. The children must also pass a swimming test. Space in the program is limited to ensure the safety of the children and the quality of the instruction.

**White Sail I and II** are the introductory levels. Beginners are introduced to and taught the basic skills of sailing. These levels cover safety, seamanship and boat handling in winds to 15km/hr velocity.

**White Sail III:** Sailors continue to learn terminology, knots and rules of the water, through games and activities. On the water, they work on boat safety and basic boat handling skills. On completion of White Sail III the beginner will be able to sail with confidence, competently in wind speeds of 4-9 knots (8-16 km/hr) and perform proficiently without supervision.

**Lost Or Damaged Boats, Parts And Equipment:**

Each sailor is responsible for making sure his/her boat is well maintained. Boats will be checked in the morning and at the end of the sailing class day by an Instructor. Sailors must report any loss or damage immediately to his/her Instructor. If, through carelessness and/or irresponsible action, boats and equipment are damaged or lost, the sailor and his/her parents will be held accountable.

The Instructor concerned will make out a written report. The Head Instructor will phone the parent to report the incident. He will then add to the Instructor's report an estimate of the cost of repair or replacement required and forward a copy of both these reports to the Club Manager. The Manager will mail a copy to the parent and charge the cost to the member's account.
