



HUDSON YACHT CLUB HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

1.SUBJECT:

This policy outlines the roles and responsibilities of the Board, employees, contractors, visitors and members of the Hudson Yacht Club, hereinafter referred to as the "Club" as those responsibilities relate to the safe operation of the Club and the health and safety of all individuals on Club property or participating in Club activities at Hudson Yacht Club.

2.RATIONALE:

The Board and members of Hudson Yacht Club are committed to the health and safety of all employees, members and visitors of the Club. Safety is the responsibility of everyone and at all times while on the Club premises. It is a shared responsibility that any individual who witnesses or becomes aware of an unsafe practice or hazard takes action to mitigate and report such.

Commitment to health and safety is the paramount concern of The Hudson Yacht Club, in that the all individuals have the right to work, volunteer, compete and use the facilities in a safe and healthy manner.

It is the Hudson Yacht Club Policy:

- To provide and maintain the grounds, buildings, docks, offices and clubhouse facilities, canteen, lifting devices, vehicles and other assets, whether permanent or temporary, in a condition that will provide a safe and risk free environment.
- To provide such information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary to ensure the health and safety of our employees, contractors, members, volunteers, visitors and competitors.

The Club Manager;

- has the overall responsibility for oversight of the Club Health and Safety Policy.
- will monitor the effectiveness of this policy within the Club through periodic review with the appointed individual(s) responsible for overall oversight.
- is to review Health and Safety issues, as an agenda item, at each regular meeting of the Board of Directors.
