## NOTICE OF RACE

## **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Current SLVYRA handicaps will apply.
- 1.3 Under rule 87, class rules relating to class membership, crew number and crew weight will not apply for the Saturday Long Distance Race.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

## **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all keel boats and multi-hulls with a valid SLVYRA handicap.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and faxing or emailing it to Hudson Yacht Club prior to 1200, September 2, 2016.
- 2.3 The registration fee, if paid by cash, cheque or money order must be paid no later than immediately after coming ashore after the Long Distance Race.
- 2.4 Entries received after 1200, September 2, 2016 will be required to pay a late entry fee.

## **3 FLEETS**

For the Long Distance Race and Course Racing, entries will be divided into the following fleets as defined by SLVYRA:

**PHRF 1-B**

**PHRF 2**

**PHRF 3**

**White Sail**

**Multi-hull**

## **4 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 Early registration: up to 1200, September 2nd  
Late registration: after 1200, September 2nd
- 4.2 LONG DISTANCE RACE: Saturday, September 3rd  
Warning signal: 1330
- 4.3 COURSE RACING: Sunday, September 4<sup>th</sup>
- 4.4 Warning Signal 1025  
Three races are scheduled
- 4.5 Monday, September 5<sup>th</sup>  
Racing for J24s  
No Warning signal after 1400
- 4.6 For Course Racing a minimum of 5 boats is required to constitute a fleet. Fleets with less than 5 boats will be started and scored as combined fleets.

## **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available on-line by September 2nd. Copies may be picked up from the desk outside the Hudson Yacht Club office from September 2nd.

## **6 SCORING**

6.1 For Course Racing one race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

6.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

## **7 PRIZES**

Long Distance Race:

- Lake of Two Mountains Cup; awarded to the first keel boat on corrected time
- HYC Annual Trophy; awarded to the first keel boat to cross the finish line
- Multi Hull Plaque; awarded to the first multi Hull on corrected time
- Ritchie Trophy; awarded to the first Corvette Class boat on corrected time (If no Corvettes, first boat on corrected time at least 25 years old and longer than 28 feet)
- Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place boat on corrected time in fleets with a minimum of 5 boats.
- Prizes will be awarded to the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place overall on corrected time

Course Racing:

Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> boats in each fleet or in combined starts with a minimum of 5 boats.

## **8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **9 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
