



## **HYC SPRING REGATTA**

#### **Notice of Race**

#### **1. Rules**

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, except as amended by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Current SLVYRA PHRF classifications will apply.
- 1.3 Current SLVYRA handicaps will apply.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES**

- 2.1 Entry is open to keel boats with a valid SLVYRA handicap
- 2.2 Classes will be PHRF 1A, PHRF 1B/2,3 J22, T22
- 2.3 The Race Committee will reserve the right to combine other PHRF classes based on the number of entries.
- 2.4 All classes must consist of three or more boats to be eligible to start a race.
- 2.5 Eligible boats may enter the Regatta by sailing on starboard tack past the RC boat's transom and requesting entry.

#### **3. FEES**

- 3.1 No entry fee will be applicable.

#### **4. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

Six races are scheduled

##### **Saturday May 28<sup>th</sup> 2016**

0930 Skipper's Meeting and Registration in HYC Clubhouse  
1100 Warning signal of the first race

##### **Sunday May 29<sup>th</sup> 2016**

1100 Warning signal of first race  
There will be no Warning Signal made after 1430 May 29<sup>th</sup>  
1630 Awards presentation at HYC.

## **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions will be available online at [www.hudsonyachtclub.com](http://www.hudsonyachtclub.com) and at registration.

## **6. VENUE**

Racing will take place on Lake of Two Mountains.

## **7. COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8. SCORING**

8.1 One race must be completed to constitute a series.

8.2 When five or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3 When six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her races excluding her worst score.

8.4 For HYC boats the first 3 races sailed on Saturday will also be scored as Saturday Series A1, A2 & A3.

## **9. BERTHING**

All club boats shall be kept in their assigned berths

Berthing for visiting boats will be available from May 27<sup>th</sup> -30<sup>th</sup> 2014.

## **10. PRIZES**

10.1 Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place boats in individual fleets if five or more boats participate.

10.2 If a fleet consists of less than five boats but more than 3, prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place.

10.3 The Race Committee may present other prizes as they deem appropriate.

## **11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk. (See rule 4 Decision to Race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Regatta

## **12. INSURANCE**

12.1 Each participating boat will have to be insured with valid third party liability insurance, minimum coverage \$1,000,000. or equivalent.
