<p>HYC Sailing Program Equipment Policy Lost or Damaged Boats, Parts and Equipment</p>

Each sailor is responsible for making sure his/her boat is well maintained. Boats will be checked before and after each session, by an Instructor. Sailors must report any loss or damage immediately to his/her Instructor. If, through carelessness and/or irresponsible action, boats and equipment are damaged or lost, the sailor will be held accountable.

In the event of such an incident, the Instructor concerned will make out a written report. The Head Instructor will then add to the Instructor's report an estimate of the cost of repair or replacement required and will forward a copy of both these reports to the Club Manager. The Manager will mail a copy to the member and charge the cost to the member's account.

I agree to abide by the Equipment Policy and accept financial responsibility for my participation in the HYC Adult Sailing Program.
