In order for children to be awarded their CanSail levels, they must meet the criteria set out for each level by CanSail Canada.

Sailors may have the chance to join other regattas with the Race Team if there is space and instructor availability. Please note that there are additional regatta registration costs that are payable directly to the hosting yacht club.

PLEASE NOTE that if your child attends a regatta over a full weekend, there will be no instruction on the Monday and Tuesday immediately following the regatta. The sailors may wish to come down and help unpack and mast boats, but their instructors will be given those days off as well.

I agree that HYC (employees, members, appointed individuals, volunteers, or Junior Sailing Program) is not liable for any damage (material or personal) suffered during training, racing, transportation to and from regattas (if applicable) or otherwise.	_____	_____
Participate in daily sailing program, which involves being out on the water every day unless the weather is a risk to the children. For CANSail III & IV, they should participate in one HYC regatta and be present for training, as your boat mate is dependent on you for successful training and racing.	_____	_____
Abide by HYC, instructor and regatta rules at all times. Sailors must not consume any alcohol or drugs while at HYC or at away regattas. Sailors shall follow the rules and schedule outlined by their instructor(s). If not following the rules and behavior expected of them, they may be sent home.	_____	_____
For CANSail III & IV, they shall have the Monday and Tuesday (or another two days selected by their instructors) off right after a weekend regatta. If they come to HYC, their instructor will not be present and no supervision will be offered.	_____	_____
For CANSail III & IV, parents are responsible for paying all regatta registration fees, food, accommodation (if applicable). It is important to follow HYC communication re: early bird deadlines to avoid having to pay higher fees.	_____	_____
For CANSail III & IV, parents are expected to help with transportation, towing and chaperoning if sailors going to an away regatta. It is not the HYC's responsibility to supervise sailors when they are not on the water outside regatta competition time.	_____	_____
