### ***SAILING INSTRUCTIONS***

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* Appendix C.
- 1.2 Oral instructions may be provided for the fleet. This changes rule 90.1.
- 1.3 White sail.
- 1.4 A minimum of 2 boats of the same class is required.

#### **2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the veranda of the HYC.

#### **3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the Hudson Yacht Club flag pole on the T pier in front of the club house veranda.
- 3.2 When flag "AP" is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes in the race signal "AP".'

#### **4 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 First flight warning 1200.
- 4.2 Second flight warning 1203.
- 4.3 Succeeding flights every 3 minutes.
- 4.4 The start for a flight is the warning for the next flight.

## 5 STARTING SIGNALS

Time in minutes	visual signal	sound signal	means
3	Flag F displayed	one	warning
2	numerical pennant	one	prep
1	Flag F removed	one long	
0	Warning signal removed	one	start

Within a flight, numerical pennant 1 means Match 1, numerical pennant 2 means Match 2 etc.

## 6 BOAT IDENTIFICATION

Boat identification will be by sail number.

## 7 RACING FORMAT

Round Robin or Best of Series to be determined race committee.

## 8 COMMUNICATIONS

VHF radio channel 71

## 9 THE COURSE

The diagram in Attachment A shows the course, including the approximate angles between

legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be

left.

## 10 MARKS

The start and finish marks will be a staff displaying an orange flag.

Turning marks will be small orange balls.

## 11 THE START

11.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal boat at the starboard end and the starting mark at the port end.

11.2 A boat starting later than 2 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes rule A4 and A5.

## 12 TARGET TIME

The target time is 15 minutes for each race.

## 13 THE FINISH

The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat and the finishing mark.

## 14 SCORING

TBD by race committee according to rule C10.5 and rule C10.6.
