SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the "RULES" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 SLVYRA PHRF rules will apply.

2 ADDITIONAL IDENTIFICATION

- 2.1 While racing, boats in the White SAIL fleet shall display a white ribbon or flag from their backstay.
- 2.2 A boat intending to race must check in with the race committee before the race by sailing on starboard tack astern of the race committee boat, hailing their sail number, and receive acknowledgement.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board of each club.

4 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1700 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1200 on the day before it will take effect.

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 Racing is scheduled as follows for all classes: RC =race committee

Race #1, Thursday June 21, RC HYC

Race#2, Thursday June 28, RC HYC

Race#3, Thursday July 5, RC HYC

Race#4, Thursday July 12, RC HYC

Race#5, Thursday July 19, RC HYC

- 5.2 There will be one race for each fleet each day.
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for Class A, (boats designated PHRF 1A, 1B, 2 & 3 is 1900.
- 5.4 The warning signal for Class B, J22 and T22 will be made as soon as practicable after the start of Class A.

6 CLASS FLAGS

Class A (PHRF 1A, 1B, 2, & 3) - numerical pennant 1,

Class B, J22 numerical pennant #2, T22 numerical pennant #3

7 RACING AREA

- 7.1 Racing Area will be located west of Quarry Point in front of HYC, wind direction permitting.

8 **THE COURSES**

8.1 The race course will be posted on the committee boat COURSE BOARD prior to the warning signal.

Legend for the course symbols to be used are:

L – Leeward

W – Windward

G - Gybe

8.2 Letters on a green background indicate that the buoy is to be left to starboard.

8.3 Letters on a red background indicate that the buoy is to be left to port.

9 **MARKS**

9.1 Course marks will be orange or yellow inflatable buoys

10 **THE START**

10.1 The starting line will be between the staff on the committee boat displaying an RC-SLVYRA and/or an orange flag at the starboard end and the orange or yellow start mark at the port end.

10.2 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area.

10.3 A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start (DNS). This changes rule A4.1.

10.4 In the case of a general recall for the Class 1 start, the Class B start will not be delayed. The new Class A start will take place after the Class B start. This modifies rule 29.2

11 **CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE**

To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will lay a new mark (or move the finishing line) and remove the original mark as soon as practicable. When in a subsequent change a new mark is replaced, it will be replaced by an original mark.

12 **THE FINISH**

The finish line will be between the flag staff on the committee boat displaying the RC-SLVYRA and/or the orange flag and the nearby windward mark.

13 **TIME LIMITS**

Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat in their class sails the course and finishes, will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes rules 35 A4 and A5.

14 **PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS**

14.1 Boats intending to lodge a protest shall inform the Race Committee Boat upon finishing and provide the name and sail number of the protested boat.

14.2 Protest shall be written on CYA forms available at HYC club office and lodged with the Race Officer or Bosun within thirty minutes of the Race Committee Boat's return to the harbour.

14.3 The Race Committee Chairman shall be responsible for convening a jury of at least 3 members.

14.4 All protests shall be heard at HYC.

15 **SCORING**

- 15.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- A) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - B) When 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - C) If there is a resail race it will be scored as the last race of the series.
- 15.2 For time limit expiration (TLE) scoring, boats not finishing within the time limit shall be scored for the finishing place two more than the number of boats scored as finished in their fleet in that race. This changes rule A4.2
- 15.3 The boat of a competitor serving Race Committee duty, for that race, will be scored with the average of number of points she scores in that series, excluding her discard.
- 15.6 There will be separate scoring for each fleet: PHRF 1A, PHRF 1B, PHRF 2/ 3, J22 T22 and White Sail.

16 **PRIZES**

- 16.1 There will be a prize for first, second and third place for each fleet of 5 or more boats.
- 16.2 Prize-giving will be at HYC on Thursday July 19th.
after the last race.

17 COMMUNICATION

- 17.1 The race committee will monitor VHF channel 71 and may communicate with competitors on this channel.
